Baptism Preparation Class

Your baby's Baptism will: 1) forgive his/her original sin (and all sins committed before Baptism), 2) make your baby a new creature, 3) be a newly adopted child of God, 4) share in the royal priesthood of Christ [1 Peter 2:9], and 5) leave an indelible spiritual mark (or character) of belonging to Christ on your baby's soul.

What a gift from God!

Presenting a child for Baptism is a serious obligation and requires a faith commitment on the part of the parents as active Catholics as well as the Godparents.

3rd Sunday of Easter, April 14, 2024

From the Deacon's Desk Reflection on Today's Gospel Reading

Today's Gospel from Luke continues the story of the two disciples who encountered the Risen Christ on the road to Emmaus. The experience of the Risen Lord could not be contained and the two returned to Jerusalem to tell the eleven that they had seen Jesus. In the midst of their conversations, Jesus appears, offering peace. The disciples were terrified, thinking that He was a ghost. While Jesus let them touch Him, they were still incredulous and did not recognize Him until after He shared a meal with them and spoke the words that helped them to understand the Scriptures. This is very similar to the Emmaus encounter.

This part of the story emphasizes the physical reality of the resurrected body of the Lord. At the time the



Gospel was written, some heretics taught that Jesus had not really suffered and that His body had been a "spiritual" expression of humanity. In today's story, the disciples touch Him; they can see the marks of the wounds in His hands and feet and eat with Him. He is no ghost! "Peace be with you." This is the first statement Jesus Christ says to the disciples upon appearing to them after rising from the dead, and it is the statement He says most often when He appears to others after the Resurrection.

What's the significance behind it? After all, Jesus wouldn't say something over and over if it didn't have some sort of deeper meaning. If Jesus were to appear in front of us today, what would our reactions be? Most likely, our first feeling would be fear since, initially, we would not recognize that it is really Jesus. Upon realizing who He is, we would immediately feel guilty and remorseful; we would not feel worthy to be in His presence.

Christ likely said "peace be with you" to calm both of these feelings. As anyone would be, the apostles were "startled and frightened" when Jesus appeared out of nowhere – and Jesus said "peace be with you" to calm their fears. Additionally, even though the Apostles were not perfect in all their actions, having abandoned Jesus during His Passion, Jesus wanted them to know that they are forgiven, that only peace lies between Him and them. It is this forgiveness and this peace that He commissioned them to preach to all the nations.

It is also this peace that He offers us today. When we approach the altar and receive Jesus' body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Sacrament of the Eucharist, He continually offers us His divine mercy, and His peace.

Whatever is going on in our lives on this third Sunday of Easter, whatever our fears, whatever our joys, whatever sufferings that we are enduring, Jesus comes to us and says, "Peace be with you!" And, we have the opportunity to open our hearts more fully to Him than we ever have before, and receive His grace, His mercy, His salvation, His infinite, unconditional love. This frees us from our worldly concerns and lifts us up. We experience Resurrection with Jesus, and are empowered to go out to the world and be witnesses of the faith just like the Apostles, loving others, supporting others, and living the Gospel, leading others to Jesus Christ.
