
What a gift from God!

Divine Mercy Sunday, April 7, 2024

From the Deacon's Desk Reflection on Today's Gospel Reading

The wonderful, magnificent Gospel reading today declares that there is no greater manifestation of the Divine Mercy than the forgiveness of sins. It invites us to close our eyes and place ourselves in the upper room with the disciples. These are the people who walked with Jesus, eyewitnesses to His preaching, teaching, and healings. Yet, when He is confronted with condemnation and death, they deny, betray, and abandon Him. And now three days later He comes to them in the upper room where they are afraid and disillusioned. Jesus stands in their midst. When they see Him, what are they thinking, what are they feeling? Their fear must have undoubtedly intensified. If we were in their shoes, what would be going through our minds? We left Him and denied Him when He need us the most. We would be racked with guilt and fear and now we are face to face with Jesus. What would we expect Him to say to us now when He appears to us after our reckless abandoning of Him? Is He angry? Will He call us out on our lack of faith?

How their hearts must have melted at the amazing, unconditional love of Jesus when He greets them with the simple word "Shalom," peace. He shows them His hands and His side, vivid reminders of what the world did to Him, yet He harbors no blame nor demands any retribution – He only offers a word of mercy. Jesus' love and mercy fill the upper room and disciples' eyes are opened to faith, to believe that He has really risen from the dead and what this means for the rest of their earthly lives and their eternity.

And then Jesus challenges them to an extraordinary commission: "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Jesus' mercy is communicated to His disciples, who in turn are sent to communicate it to the world.

How fitting that this Gospel passage is read every year on Divine Mercy Sunday, a day for us to open our hearts in a special way to the Divine Mercy that Jesus offers us every day of our lives. Are we holding back in receiving the mercy of Jesus? Are there things in our lives that we struggle to let go of? Do we need to forgive ourselves? Do we need to forgive others? Jesus is in our midst saying, "Shalom", "Peace". He offers us His saving grace. He offers us freedom from sin and freedom from our fears. All we have to do is open our hearts, receive, and be healed.
